## We have completed the review of the Pre-Connection Enquiry.

Uisce Éireann has reviewed the pre-connection enquiry in relation to a Water & Wastewater connection for a Housing Development of 750 unit(s) at Site at, Lioncor (Kilbride), Arklow, Wicklow, (the **Development**).

Based upon the details provided we can advise the following regarding connecting to the networks;

#### Water Connection

## Feasible Subject to upgrades

In order to accommodate the proposed connection at the development, upgrade works are required to increase the capacity of the water network. These works are currently estimated to include the following and would require further review via pressure and flow assessment at connection application stage:

- Network adjustments to valving arrangements/DMAs on the existing network
- Upgrade approx 900m of 6"uPVC/AC main to 300mm ID
- Upgrade approx 300m of 6" AC main to 300mm ID
- Tie in 50mm uPVC main in Ticknock Lane

- Install approx 160m of new 300mm ID pipe to connect to the existing 315mm HPP main (main site connection)
- Provide secondary connection main to the upgraded 300mm pipe

It should be noted that, there is approx. 180m pipe crossing bridge over the Avoca river in included in the upgrades here. This is a protected bridge and necessary statutory consents would be required.

Uisce Éireann does not currently have any plans to carry out the works required to provide the necessary upgrade and capacity. Should you wish to have such upgrade works progressed, Uisce Éireann will require you to provide a contribution of a relevant portion of the costs for the required upgrades.

- A concept design report, relating to this site via a Project Works Services Ageement (PWSA), outlined a preferred wastewater discharge solution for this site. progress a connection to the Uisce Eireann wastewater network, the applicant must enter into a further Project Works Service Agreement to complete the detail design for this connection. Uisce Éireann does not currently have any plans to carry out the works required to provide the necessary upgrade and capacity. Should you wish to have such upgrade works progressed, Uisce Éireann will require you to provide a contribution of a relevant portion of the costs for the required upgrades

In addition, the Arklow trunk sewer project and new Wastewater Treatment Plant will need to be completed before a connection can be made - this is due to be completed Q1 2025.
